Purpose of the paper	To draw the attention of the Board to this strategic direction for the partnership, to discuss and enable feedback into future activities.		
Brief summary of the paper	<p>Court have agreed a concept of 'One UHI' which is outlined in the attached slides. There has been robust challenge and debate around the subject between Principals and the VC since Court approval of the concept. In summary a variety of models would be possible in the future (and which will need to be explored) which would meet the vision of a federal collegiate university. For the short term the partnership needs to work better together and improve our efficiency and effectiveness. There is general agreement that we need to plan regionally and ensure we deliver locally. At Partnership Council it was agreed that groups would be established to focus on key priorities for the partnership to support the first steps of One UHI.</p> <p>These groups are:</p> <p>FE strategy; Performance Matrix; Financial recovery; Recruitment and Admissions and Curriculum and Pedagogy.</p>
