Basic Firefighting & Prevention (Seafish)

Accreditation: Seafish

Length of course: 1 day

Who is this course aimed at: This course is mandatory for all commercial fishermen. It is one of the basic safety training courses that are required by all commercial fishermen and also meets the training requirements for crew requiring fire-fighting training on small commercial workboats.

Entry Requirements: None

Course Outcomes: Seafish Basic Firefighting & Prevention Certificate

Course Description: Topics covered during the course include:

- fire and the dangers it presents at sea.
- fire prevention.
- the principles of firefighting at sea.
- the use of basic firefighting equipment to safely extinguish fires.

The course includes classroom work and practical exercises which include the use of firefighting equipment to extinguish fires. There is a short written test at the end the course.
