How?

You will study part-time, which involves attendance at college as well as work experience. In year 1 you will complete the NPA award. In year 2 you will have a placement of approx. 1 day per week. This will be arranged around your 6th year timetable. You will complete your SVQ units during this time.

You should be studying (and expected to achieve) English at N5 and Maths at N4 (or equivalent).
