<b>Qualifications:</b>	National Certificate (NC) Engineering Systems (SCQF level 5) Skills for Work: Engineering Skills (SCQF level 5)
<b>Intended for:</b>	Pupils who are interested in a career in the engineering industry who are looking for broad-based training in both practical skills and knowledge
<b>Entry:</b>	English and Maths at a minimum of N4 (or equivalent). Physics or Engineering Science would be an advantage
<b>Attendance:</b>	College sessions will be on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons during term time (from 1.30 to 4.30). School sessions will be Monday and Wednesday mornings with a college lecturer. A one-week full time practical skills block will be scheduled at the end of the programme
