Brief summary of the paper	An economic impact assessment has been completed by BiGGAR Economics for the University of the Highlands and Islands. The assessment determined that in 2019, the university partnership contributed £653 million to the Scottish economy and supported 7,200 jobs across Scotland. UHI contributed £560 million to the Highlands and Islands, Moray and Perthshire economies and supported 6,200 jobs throughout the region. For every £1 spent on the university, the university partnership put £5 back into the Scottish economy, £4 of which was retained in the Highlands and Islands, Moray and Perthshire. A separate report was also presented for Shetland. Shetland College UHI and the NAFC Marine Centre UHI were found to contribute £34 million and support 250 jobs throughout the Shetland Islands.
