#### Causes

#### **Owner**

- Governing body does not have an appropriate balance of skills and experience.
- Role of a governor/director is onerous and it is difficult to attract a broad range of high calibre individuals to serve for nonremunerated roles.
- Individuals do not understand their roles.
- College does not adhere to Code of Good Governance.
- Board Secretary vacancy

Board of Management; Chair & Board Secretary

### **Impacts**

- Board is unable to discharge its duties properly.
- Recruitment and retention of governor/director is challenging.
- Auditors find poor decision making at Board Level
- Auditors challenge the college on its lack of adherence to the Code of Good Governance.

### **Actions to** minimize risk in place **(1)**:

- Board members induction and Board members complete core training. Board Secretary currently updating Training Records and confirming with Directors who has completed training.
- Annual Development Reviews are completed. These are currently ongoing.
- Training and upskilling of Board Secretary.
- Regular meetings between Principal,
   Secretary, and Chairs.

# Actions to minimize risk in place (2):

- Implementation of Code of Good governance. Over 8 hours of meetings with UHI Internal Auditor, to assess and understand what the remaining actions are to complete implementation.
- Completing Assignation to Regional Strategic Body. 11 criteria under Section 7, Clause 2 of F&HE (Scotland) Act 2005 to which UHI must assess.
- Undertaking Audits and Review of Audits by Audit Committee. 2021-22 External Audit Complete. Internal Audit Reports ongoing.

# Actions to minimize risk in place (3):

- Register of Interests renewed each year
- Management of Turnover of Directors.
   Recruitment of Fisheries Industry tbc Summer 2023.
   Staff Directors' elections September 2023. HISA
   Shetland Depute President vacant from 26<sup>th</sup> May 2023.
- Regular review of:
  - Board members skills and industry links by Search and Nominations Committee
  - Terms of Reference of Committees by Board of Management
  - Training progress of Directors by Board Secretary
