## 2023/24 Fees

We are currently working towards a course fee list for 2023/24 for UHI Shetland.

An updated course costing template has been provided for assessing FE course delivery, and at present Paula Watson is working on the income and costs associated with each of our courses. This should provide the evidence base with which to update our price list, particularly in relation to the non-standard courses which don't sit directly within the UHI fee framework. The course pricing review also sits in the context of the funding situation, for example the reduction in FE credit allocation, which may mean that some of our courses, including short courses and SVQs, require a more substantial pricing change.

The following table outlines the 2023/24 fees which are already determined because they are set either by the Scottish Funding Council or by UHI. The fees for the Health and Social Care longer courses have also already been set and agreed for the next few years as part of the SIC tender.
